Age Groups

Little Learners Pre-School welcomes children from 3 up to 6 years. Our children are divided into 2 classes:

- Busy Hands (3-4 years)
- Little Thinkers (4-5 Years)

Our Timings

Children attend preschool Sunday to Thursday, 8.00 am to 12.30 pm.
We have an early class from 7.30 am to 8.00 am.
We have a late class from 12.30 pm to 2.30 pm.

Uniform

Little Learners has gingham dresses for the girls and gingham shorts with white shirts for the boys. Uniforms are to be purchased from the school.

SNACK TIME

The children will have a mid-morning snack at 10am. Parents are requested to provide a labelled cool bag or box containing a healthy snack such as a small sandwich, fruit, yoghurt, crisps and biscuits. Please do not send glass bottles, fizzy drinks, chocolate, sweets, peanuts and junk food i.e. chicken nuggets, burgers, etc. At Little Learners Pre-School, we encourage healthy eating habits.

Curriculum

At Little Learners Pre-School, the programs provide a stimulating and supportive environment with a balance between learning and fun, structure and choice, along with group and individual exploration. The children are given opportunities which promote social, emotional, physical and language development.

We offer a well-rounded bilingual education, which develops strong moral and ethical values and prepares its students to be inquirers, analytical thinkers, and lifelong learners enabling them to respond to the challenges of modern life.

The children participate in a wide range of activities, including developmentally appropriate work with literacy and numeracy, science and social studies. They engage in cooking, art and craft projects, dramatic play, story-telling, music and physical education. Beginning computer skills are taught in the computer laboratory.



After School Activities

This facility is ideal for working parents or for parents who have children in different classes that finish at different times. Our After School Care facility is provided every day from 1.30pm to 2.30pm and is run by one of the class teachers. The children finish their school snack and then enjoy lots of fun, energetic activities such as dancing, simple assault courses, games and races.

Parents can enroll their child up for 3, 4 or 5 days a week and must sign up for the duration of the term. This facility is only open to children attending the school.

Extra-curricular activities make a huge difference in the children that partake in these types of programs and classes. We have been able to see kids grow and have learned that they can do a lot more than we ever knew they were capable of!!

Communication

We believe that it's important for teachers to have active relationships with parents. We believe that parents who are actively involved in the KG and with what their children are learning will benefit the students and their development. We also believe that the child's family is their first teacher. Our job is to create a link between home and school.
